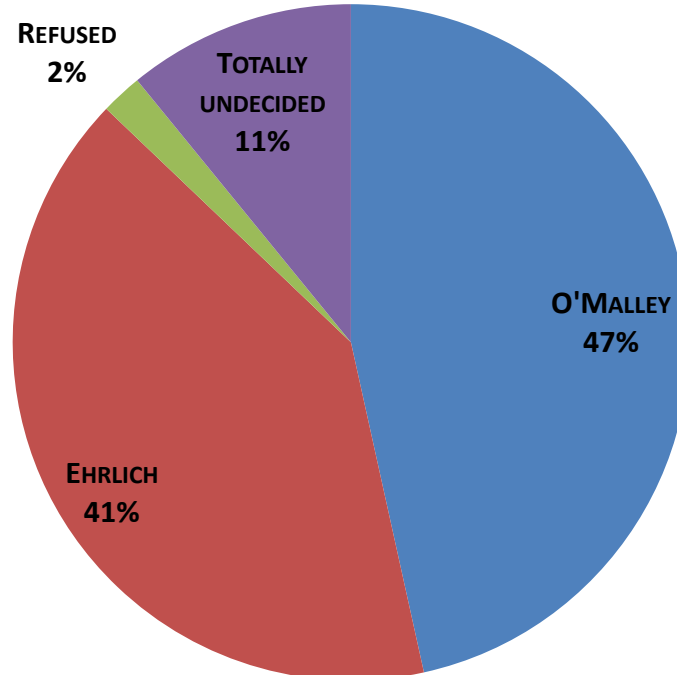


## **Center Maryland / OpinionWorks Statewide Voter Survey**

**Question: If the 2010 election for governor were held today, and the candidates for governor were (*rotate*): [Bob Ehrlich the Republican (or) Martin O'Malley the Democrat], for whom would you vote?  
(*If initially undecided*): Do you lean towards one of them at this time?**



The Center Maryland / OpinionWorks Statewide Voter Survey was conducted August 13 through August 18, 2010. The telephone survey questioned 600 likely General Election voters statewide, and has a margin of error of 4 percentage points.

The results from the previous question are limited only to the 551 likely voters who said they are certain or probable to vote in the November general election. It has a margin of error of 4.2 percentage points.
