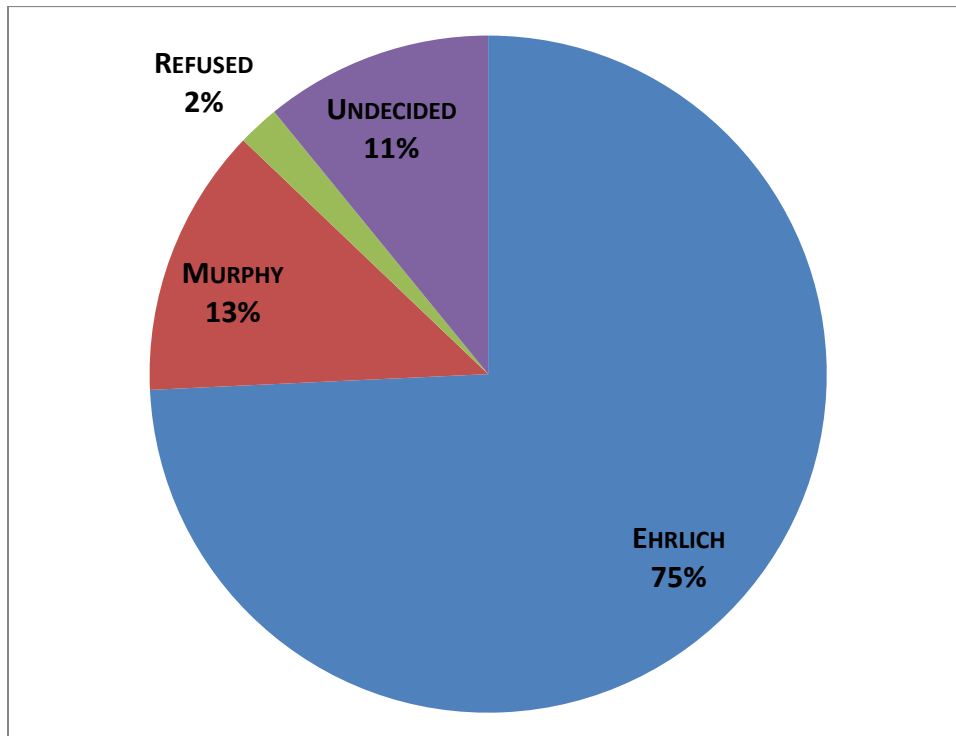


Center Maryland / OpinionWorks Statewide Voter Survey

Question: If the Republican primary election were held today, and the candidates were (rotate) Bob Ehrlich or Brian Murphy, for whom would you vote?

(If initially undecided): Do you lean towards one of them at this time?



The Center Maryland / OpinionWorks Statewide Voter Survey was conducted August 13 through August 18, 2010. The telephone survey questioned 600 likely General Election voters statewide, and has a margin of error of 4 percentage points.

For questions focused on Republican voters, the poll interviewed 143 likely Republican voters, and has a margin of error of 8.2 percentage points.

The results from the previous question are limited only to the 132 likely Republican voters who said they are certain or probable to vote in the September Republican primary election. It has a margin of error of 8.5 percentage points.
